PIANOFORTE WP5 - Objectives

To establish an **oversight committee for infrastructures** that will ensure that all infrastructure needs required for the implementation PIANOFORTE projects are recognised and served

To provide support for the radiation protection research community and PIANOFORTE partners/projects to access cross-national infrastructures

To promote **harmonization of quality standards**, practices and protocols in all areas relevant to implementation of the research roadmap

To develop a strategic work plan for **utilisation**, **novel uses and inter-operability** of key RPR infrastructures

To develop a plan and vision for FAIR (findable, accessible, interoperable and reusable) data management and approaches to exploitation of archived data in radiation protection R&I

To establish **close links with the OFFERR project** to benefit from each other's expertise, to foster collaborations without duplication of activities, and to carry out joint actions favouring access to research infrastructures
